SEARCH AND SEIZURE

A few pointers on Search and Seizure:

- The dog team comes once or twice a week to search the school and all parking lots.
- The dogs will alert on as little as a couple of marijuana seeds or buds.
- The dogs will alert on bottles or cans of alcohol that have not been opened.
- Any firecrackers, smoke bombs or ammunition will cause an alert.
- The dog team handlers do a visual search of the cars.
- Clubs, weapons, toy weapons and items such as inappropriate videos are found with the visual search.

ANY ALERT WITH EVIDENCE (<u>NO MATTER HOW SMALL</u>) WILL RESULT IN A CENTRAL OFFICE CONFERENCE FOR THE STUDENT WITH POSSIBLE REMOVAL FROM SCHOOL TO AN ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL.

What you can do to avoid a bad incident:

- ✓ Monitor you<mark>r friends' beh</mark>avior while they are in your car. You will be h<mark>eld responsible</mark> for their misbehavior.
- √ Follow the established/expected traffic patterns on campus as designed.
- ✓ Be aware of problems caused by driving your parent's car to school or driving your car after loaning it to a friend (even an adult).
- ✓ Check your car after trips with small kids. The will leave dangerous toys (toy guns, bows and arrows, sling shots, firecrackers etc.) in your car.
- ✓ Clean your car after hunting trips removing all guns and ammunition.

REMEMBER THAT IT TAKES VERY LITTLE FOR THE DOGS TO ALERT!
