PATHWAYS IN TECHNOLOGY EARLY COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL (P-TECH)

The goal of Early College High Schools (ECHS) is to provide students with an opportunity to graduate with 60+ hours of transferable college credits and earn a two-year associate degree along with their high school diploma, tuition free, saving families thousands of dollars in college costs.

Our P-TECH program provides a small, personalized community offering rigorous college preparatory curriculum that engages students as it prepares them for high-skilled and high-demand careers. Although many high schools across the nation offer concurrent dual-enrollment opportunities, those programs traditionally serve the highest-achieving students of their class. Our P-TECH programs will target all students entering 9th grade.

Priority is given to students from traditionally underrepresented student groups as identified by the Texas Education Agency Pathways in Technology Early College High School (P-TECH) Blueprint - Benchmark 2.

In addition to ECHS opportunities, P-TECH Early College High Schools provide work-based learning experiences at every grade level by establishing agreements with industry partners. Through internships and apprenticeships, students may earn work credentials such as licenses and certificates aligned to their chosen pathway.

Through our P-TECH program students earn an associate degree and may choose from 4 pathways in high-demand fields. The fields are:

- Electrical Technology
- Renewable Energy Resources
- Lineman Program
- Energy Business Related Coursework
