Safety and Parking

We care about the safety of each person visiting our school. In order to maintain a safe and orderly pickup and drop off, we need to have procedures that everyone will follow. Please keep these in mind:

- In the morning we have only two drop off doors. One is near the cafeteria and the other is the main entrance by the flagpole.
- Parking is open in both the faculty lot and the visitor lot. The drive through lanes are only for driving through, not parking. Parking in the drive through lane is a violation of safety code since these are marked as fire lanes.
- Handicapped parking spots are reserved for those with handicap plates.
- Watch for pedestrians when you back out of a parking spot and drive with caution please!
- **During Dismissal time, the only door for visitor entry is the main door.**
