H.V. Helbing ES is a traditional neighborhood school that offers grades EE-5th grade. It is a Title I campus in Fort Worth ISD, located in Fort Worth, Texas. Fort Worth is a growing suburb in the DFW Metroplex. H.V. Helbing ES is part of the Diamond Hill community which is predominantly a Hispanic community in north Fort Worth. This community is unique in that it is a multi-generational Hispanic community.

We only have one bus, a majority of our students are within walking distance. Additionally, bus transportation is provided to the students in Special Education.

Our enrollment is about 390 students.

Attendance rate for Spring 2022 based on Texas education Agency was at 94.2% and district attendance rate was at 92.8%.

H.V. Helbing ES has a predominant Hispanic population of about 97.2%. Other student groups that attend our campus are:

White: about 0.5%

African-American: about 1.5%

American Indian: about 0.5%

Two or more races: about 0.3%

The last published mobility rate was 9.4. This average mobility rate is significantly lower than our district 16.5% and our state 13.6%.




